Kyle Lived, Loved, and Fought. He fought like hell against cancer. He was selected by Mid-South Men's Health Organization as the recipient of a grant in 2012 from the First Annual Bowling for Balls Tournament. The 501C declared the loving cup tournament trophy "The Douglas Cup" in his honor and will continue to remember him for his tremendous courage at such a young age.

Kyle excelled in writing and was awarded a grant in 2012 from The SamFund, a foundation supporting young adult cancer survivors. Kyle's original essay was one of a handful of winners out of thousands of entries . Kyle was also awarded grants from The American Cancer Society and Angel Med Flights.

He wanted his loved ones to laugh at the happy memories that he shared with you, smile when you think of him and to celebrate the blessed life he was given.

The Family is following Kyle's wishes, to not have a service or visitation. They will have a Celebration of Life Service on Sunday, January 29th at Growlers located at 1911 Poplar Avenue in Mid-Town Memphis from 2-6 pm.
