She also enjoyed reading about mental health and nutrition for her chosen field of work. She loved herbal tinctures, medicine and science. She also enjoyed yoga, gardening, and finding items on the side of the road, repairing and restoring them, and then selling them.

Emily was fun-loving and adventurous. She and Gordon travelled to Haiti in 2013 on a medical mission trip to St. Vincent's School for Handicapped Children in Port au Prince, and her loving heart was deeply moved by the experience. She loved travelling with her family, most recently to Puerto Rico, as well.

Emily and Gordon were best friends, lovers, and were truly inseparable. They quickly fell in love and never turned back. Gordily was their nickname together, and will be carried on in Gordon's heart.

Emily is survived by her husband Gordon, her sons Hudson and Brady, her parents, her dearest friend Kristin Stewart, her beloved Weimaraner Gracie (who she referred to as "Grandma Gracie") and a host of aunts, uncles, cousins and friends.
