Mary Ann Hahn Morrison passed away on Friday, July 2, 2021 just 3 days shy of her 93rd birthday after a long illness. She was born Mary Adrian to Anthenor Hahn and Mary Louise McNamara Hahn in Mobile but soon became known as Mary Ann. When she became a grandmother at 34, she became Maw to family and friends alike. She was simply Mary to the hundreds of diners who requested her table in her 42 years of service at Red Lobster, and who she considered friends. She leaves 4 children: Donald E.
