He was preceded in death by his father, John “Jiggs” Glover, and his nephew, John Manley, and his son Lonnie Smith.

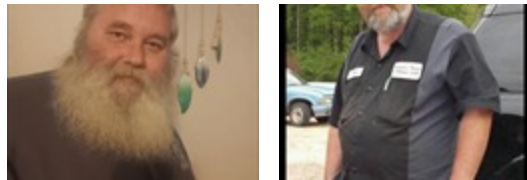
