Philip Larry Gould, 73, of Memphis, TN, passed away at his home on November 25, 2025. Larry was born February 25, 1952, in Wadsworth, OH, to Rev. Philip L. Gould and Gertrude L. (Murphy) Gould. Surviving are his two sisters, Phyllis L. Beaver of Macomb, IL, and Patricia L. McMinn of Wilmore, KY. Also surviving are nieces Tracey E. (Darin J.) Ratermann of Columbia, MO; Kelley A. Larry went through school in the Wadsworth, OH, City School System, and attended United Electronics Institute (Cuyahoga Falls, OH) to pursue his interest in electronics and engineering. After finishing his studies at United Electronics, he took a job in Memphis, TN, in the music field as a Recording Engineer, which he loved. After this company closed, Larry free-lanced as an engineer and producer for several production companies in the Memphis area. He did POS Programming for First Tennessee Bank Operations Center before he began working at Memphis International Airport, first as a Ground Service Agent and finally as a Transportation Security Administration (TSA) Officer, until he retired from the Airport because of health issues.

He loved his many dogs over the years, loved meeting people, making and listening to music, and traveling. He leaves many friends in his adopted home City of Memphis.
