Sherry Berkeley Friederick of Huntington, WV died Friday, September 20, 2019, at Methodist Germantown Hospital, surrounded by family. Visitation will be conducted Wednesday, September 25th at noon, with a memorial service to follow at 1 p.m. at Christ Presbyterian Church, 949 10th Avenue (B'nai Sholom Congregation) with Dr. John Minihan officiating.

Sherry was born February 23, 1948, in Milton, WV, eldest daughter of the late Thomas and Marcheta Berkeley. Sherry was steadfastly devoted to her faith as a member of Christ Presbyterian Church and her family, most of all her grandchildren. She served the community through her work with the Team for West Virginia Children, as well as other non-profit organizations. She developed innovative programs to promote early childhood brain development through parent education and interaction, and was also a tireless advocate for children with special needs.

She was preceded in death by grandson Michael Perry.
